


Conflict Minerals

To Whom It May Concern:

The U.S. conflict Minerals Law (Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act) became effective on July 21st, 2012. The law defines Conflict Minerals as certain minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of Congo ("DRC") or adjoining countries. Regulations have been implemented regarding the law and companies are required to report the use of any Conflict Minerals originating from the DRC or adjoining countries. The minerals that are the subject of the law are gold, tantalum, tin and tungsten ("Conflict Minerals").

We hereby confirm that SD GmbH does not knowingly source Conflict Minerals or materials which contain Conflict Minerals originating from the DRC as described in the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and consequently that used material do not contain Conflict Minerals originating from the DRC or adjoining countries.

This confirmation is given after due enquiry with and respective confirmation by our suppliers that materials they supply to SD GmbH not contain Conflict Minerals.
